

Teaching Methods

Microteaching Preliminary Lecture Assignment

To be completed by Friday Week 1, 5pm. Groups of 3, 5 minutes *max* per person. (5 points)

Decide on an engineering lesson you want to deliver. You will use this example throughout the quarter when we do in-class planning, and your final presentation in the class will be the delivery of this full lesson (~ 15 minutes). Your first assignment is to deliver an introduction to this lesson during a 5-minute recorded video. You will have an opportunity later in the quarter to view your video and look for positive aspects of your presentation and areas for improvement. This will be helpful in preparing for your final teaching activity.

- During week 1, develop a 5-minute introduction to your lesson. You will not be able to get through a complete lesson, but you should be able to come to a good breaking point for an introduction.
- Sign up on the schedule for a time slot to record your lesson. You will be in a group of 2 or 3.
- Make your recording as a group using the video recorder in the ME office. Be sure to include your name, in writing, at the start of each video (so we can track whose videos have been completed).
- Stop the video right at 5 minutes, whether you are done or not.
- Return the camera to the ME office.
